

## BREEDING BEEF DIVISION

In County Heifers Only

Arrival Time – Saturday, **March 26<sup>th</sup> from** 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Check-In – Saturday, **March 26<sup>th</sup> from** 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Judging Date – Sunday, **March 27<sup>th</sup>**, 9:00 a.m.

RELEASE AT CONCLUSION OF SHOW

THIS IS A HEIFER SHOW ONLY – NO BULLS

1. This division is subject to the General Rules and these Division rules.
2. Open to all 4-H and FFA members that are enrolled in public, private, parochial schools or Home Educated students. If an exhibitor requires a General Exception Form (refer to Page 2), it will be due on **January 18, 2022**. Each application will be reviewed for compliance.
3. There will be a validation held for the Breeding Beef Division for Montgomery County Fair on **January 18, 2022** from 2PM – 7PM at the Montgomery County Fair Office, where original registration papers for all registered heifers or a Bill of Sale for only heifers validated for Montgomery County Fair Replacement Heifer Show will be processed. **Exhibitor is required to bring original Registration paper(s) OR Bill of Sale ONLY IF heifer has been tagged-in for the Montgomery County Fair Replacement Heifer Show, as well as two copies of said papers to verify eligibility.** Exhibitor must present ALL papers of ALL heifers he or she is planning to exhibit at the Breeding Beef Show at the Montgomery County Fair. There will be no substitutions. Papers will be checked by Montgomery County Breeding Beef Committee. Exhibitor should be present. Parent or guardian MUST be present to sign validation card. Heifers will not need to be present; this is a paper validation only. Committee has the right to check tattoo numbers in ear at time of Show. All validated Montgomery County Fair Replacement Heifers and Montgomery County Fair Scramble Heifers MUST present Registration papers or Bill of Sale at this validation to exhibit their heifer in the Montgomery County Fair Breeding Beef Show.
4. Grand and Reserve banners will be awarded to overall show winners. Grand and Reserve Belt Buckles will be awarded to division winners. Showmanship jackets will be awarded. Leather ribbons will be given to Champion and Reserve Breed Champions.
  - a. All others will receive ribbons.
  - b. The Fair Association will contribute \$1500 to prize money and have a 60/40 payback on entry fees. (The 60% will go to the exhibitors, 40% to the Fair).
  - c. If only one entry in a class, 2<sup>nd</sup> place prize money will be awarded.
5. **Breeding beef heifers showing only in the Breeding Beef Show MUST be registered in the Herd-book of their Association in ONLY the name of the junior owner on or before November 10 of the year preceding the show. Purchase date, delivery date, possession date, transfer date and registration date must all take place on or before November 10 of the year preceding the show.**
6. No grooming material is allowed. This is a "Blow and Go" Show. All heifers will be shown with hair in a natural state WITHOUT the use of glues, adhesives, paints, etc. Heifers with any type of glue, paint, adhesive, etc. in the hair will be disqualified and premiums forfeited. Heifers will be toweled.
7. Stomach pumping, drenching tubes or any other method (by esophagus) is prohibited.
8. All breeding stock must be double-tied.
9. No bedding hay.
10. Judging will be done in the following order:

**AMERICAN DIVISION** – Brahman, Brahmousin, Brangus/Red Brangus, Beefmaster, Santa Gertrudis, Simbrah , ABC and ARB. The first and second place of each breed will be called back to choose the Grand and Reserve of the American Division.

**ENGLISH DIVISION** – Angus/Red Angus, Hereford/Polled Hereford and Shorthorn. The first and second place of each breed will be called back to choose the Grand and Reserve of the English Division.

**EXOTIC DIVISION** – Charolais, Chianina, Maine Anjou, Simmental, ORB and AOB. The first and second place of each breed will be called back to choose the Grand and Reserve of the Exotic Division.

**MINIATURE CLASS** – Any breed as specified above under the American, English and Exotic Divisions.

Maximum height for Miniature Class is 45" on mature females. All entries will be measured for height prior to showing. Designated Show officials will conduct all height measurements. Those exceeding the 45" height requirement will not be allowed to compete in the Miniature Class.

Breeds will be broken down into the following classes:

- CLASS 1: BORN AFTER 10/1/2021
- CLASS 2: 6/1/2021 – 9/30/2021
- CLASS 3: 2/1/2021 – 5/31/2021
- CLASS 4: 10/1/2020 – 1/31/2021
- CLASS 5: 6/1/2020 – 9/30/2020
- CLASS 6: 2/1/2020 – 5/31/2020
- CLASS 7: 9/1/2019 – 1/31/2020

\*5 or more entered will determine breed assembly at the discretion of the Show Chairman and/or Officer in Charge.

10. Entries must be completed and paid by **Friday, February 4, 2022, at 5:00PM**. Entry fee is \$20/hd. (See page five (5) of Rule Book for Online Entry details)

11. Breeding beef entries will be released immediately following the breeding beef show on **Sunday, March 27, 2022**.

12. There will be one stall assigned per entry (heifer). Said entry (heifer) and exhibitor has right of occupancy and/or use of only the single assigned stall space. The Committee reserves the right to police stalls at any time to determine if any non-assigned stall space should be filled. Exceptions to this rule will be considered on a case by case basis to be determined by the Chairman.

**JR. AND SR. SHOWMANSHIP WILL BE HELD AFTER THE SHOW AND IS OPEN TO ALL EXHIBITORS WHO WISH TO PARTICIPATE. YOU PAY \$5.00 (CASH) AT THE ENTRY GATE AND THE WINNER WILL BE AWARDED ALL PROCEEDS AT THE EXIT GATE. JR'S = 13 & UNDER, SR'S = 14 & OVER AS OF THE DAY OF THE SHOW.**
