TURKEY DIVISION

Arrival & Check-In Time – Saturday, March 26th, 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Judging Date – Saturday, March 26th, 12:00 p.m. RELEASE AT CONCLUSION OF SHOW

- 1. This division is subject to the General Rules and these Division Rules. If an exhibitor requires a General Exception Form (refer to Page 2), it will be due when Intent to Show forms are due on November 19, 2021. Each application will be reviewed for compliance.
- 2. A pen consists of one (1) turkey, HENS OR TOMS MAY BE EXHIBITED.
- 3. One (1) entry per exhibitor.
- 4. Each pen of one bird must weigh at least fifteen (15) pounds with no maximum weight.
- 5. Pens will be sifted prior to entry into the show. This sift will consist of a check for breast blisters, bruises and weight. Any bird not appearing healthy will be sifted.
- 6. Sifted turkeys will be turned over to the Montgomery County Fair Association for removal from Fairgrounds.
- 7. The first turkey presented to the sifter will be the pen. No substitutions.
- 8. All Turkeys must be ordered through Texas A & M University. Exhibitors are responsible for placing their own order for their turkeys. Turkey Intent-To-Show forms must match original order. If family ordered, each family member must be listed on Intent-To-Show form.
- 9. Wing band numbers must be turned in to the Fair Office by November 19, 2021, along with the Turkey Intent to Show form. Forms may be emailed to intents@mcfa.org. If a form is mailed or hand-delivered, it must be IN THE FAIR OFFICE by the aforementioned deadline date. NO FAXES ACCEPTED.

NO TURKEY WILL BE SHOWN WITHOUT WING-BAND IN PLACE. BANDS WILL BE CHECKED FOR NUMBER AND CONDITION.

- 10. All birds must be cared for by the exhibitor. **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING FEED AND WATER FOR THEIR ENTRY. EXHIBITORS WHO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW THE FOLLOWING YEAR.**
- 11. NO CARRYING CAGES, FEED, ETC. WILL BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN IN THE SHOW AREA.
- 12. The use of drugs not approved for Turkeys used for human consumption will not be allowed.
- 13. Entries must be completed by Friday, February 4, 2022, by 5:00PM with a \$20 entry fee/pen. (See page five (5) of Rule Book for Online Entry details)
- 14. A helper of an exhibitor must be a current member in good standing of a Montgomery County 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.
