## JUNIOR FINE ARTS SHOW

The general rules for all Junior Non-Livestock Shows apply to the Fine Arts Show as well as the following special rules.

- 1. Individuals can exhibit a maximum of (4) four entries in this show.
- 2. Online Entries must be completed and paid (\$10 entry fee per item) by Friday, February 4, 2022, by 5:00PM. (See page forty-four (44) of Rule Book for Online Entry details)
- 3. All art should be the original work of the artist. NO COPIES will be accepted.
- 4. MCFA log sheet is required for all Fine Arts entries. https://mcfa.org/events/junior-fine-arts/
- 5. Exhibitors name shall not appear on the front or back of the project, no exceptions. ONLY THE ENTRY # shall be present on the BACK of the project, completed at check-in by show personnel.
- 6. No more than one student may work on an entry.
- 7. Entries may not include:
  - a. Plastic figures
  - b. commercial objects or lettering may be used as part of entry
- 8. Flat entries:
  - a. Must be matted or mounted on rigid poster board.
  - b. The board should be heavy enough to prevent sagging.
  - c. The mat should be no larger than 3" on any side.
  - d. Minimum 11"x14" matted, maximum 22"x28" matted, UNFRAMED.
  - e. No framed pieces, glass, unmounted or un-matted work will be accepted for judging.
  - f. All work must be DRY
  - g. Charcoals and pastels should be sprayed and protected from elements with a transparent protective covering.
- 9. Canvas entries:
  - a. Minimum 8"x10" up to Maximum 20"x24"
  - b. Unframed canvas only.
  - c. All work must be DRY.
- 10. Sculpture and Constructions:
  - a. Entries may be constructed of clay, metal, wood, chicken wire, papier mache, assemblages or combinations of the above.
  - b. Wire sculptures must have a base.
  - c. Sculptures made of wax, toothpicks or other fragile materials will not be accepted.
  - d. Sculptures cannot be any larger than 20" horizontally or vertically.
  - e. All work must be DRY
  - f. Charcoals and pastels should be sprayed and protected from elements with a transparent protective covering.
- 11. Inappropriate subject matter will be disqualified at Chairman's discretion.

## JUNIOR FINE ARTS SHOW AWARDS

The preliminary judges may pick up to ten top winners from all five divisions combined. These exhibitors will receive Finalist Ribbons and **must be present at the final judging.** Individuals cannot make the top 10 more than once. The Final Judging will pick the Grand, Reserve, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place winner. Up to ten Honorable Mentions may be selected and will receive an Honorable Mention Ribbon.
