

JUNIOR PHOTOGRAPHY SHOW

The general rules for All Junior Non-Livestock Shows apply to the Photography Show as well as the following special rules.

1. Individuals can exhibit up to (12) twelve entries in this show.
2. Online Entries must be completed and paid (\$10 entry fee per item) by **Friday, February 4, 2022, by 5:00PM**. (See page forty-four (44) of Rule Book for Online Entry details)
3. **PHOTOGRAPHY SHOW ENTRY:**
 - Check-In Entry at the Fair Office on March 7th-11th & March 14th & 15th, 2022 by 5PM
 - For Each Paid Online Entry: (You will need the below)**
 - Your Photograph
 - The required Log Sheet.
 - One (1) entry per flat sealed envelope, PROVIDED BY EXHIBITOR.
 - The student's name, phone number, email address, and description of the photo written on the outside of the envelope.
 - Nothing is written on the Photo itself.
4. All photographs must be 8" X 10" in size.
5. Photographs with the following will **not** be accepted:
 - Any outside borders or titles showing.
 - Matted, mounted or framed photographs.
 - Collages of any kind.
 - Panoramic photographs.
 - Date stamps and watermarks.
6. An MCFA log sheet must be kept on all photography entries. <https://mcfa.org/events/junior-photography/>
7. Exhibitor's name shall not appear on the front or the back of the project, no exceptions.
8. All photographs will be judged on the following:
 - Focus
 - Exposure
 - Lighting
 - Print Quality
 - Subject
 - Composition
 - Impact
 - Uniqueness
9. Photographs may be color, or black and white and may be digitally enhanced.
10. Inappropriate subject matter will be disqualified at Chairman's discretion.
11. Previous entries will not be allowed to be entered.

Individuals cannot make top 10 more than once in this show. The Final Judging will pick the Grand, Reserve, 3rd, 4th, and 5th place winners. Up to ten Honorable Mentions may be selected, and will receive Honorable Mention Ribbons.
