The purpose of the Junior Committee is to provide young adults with an opportunity to develop leadership skills, perform community service, and become aware of the business and operations of the Montgomery County Fair and Rodeo. Junior Committee member duties will include providing outreach in the members' communities and schools, as well as aiding volunteers and staff leading up to and during the Fair. The Junior Committee volunteerism may consist of assisting at fundraisers, in grounds and office preparation, assisting with special contests on stages and/or in departments, helping to conduct opening ceremonies and award presentations, etc. Throughout the Fair year, Junior Committee members will assist with various tasks based on the requests of Committee Chairman and provide general assistance to the Fair Association Staff as needed.

Other possible opportunities for this committee throughout the year include participation in many local parade's, community service projects, educational field trips, workshops, and its own Membership Appreciation Banquet.
